LIFE PROFILE OF THE DISCOVERER HIS EARLY LIFE

The great saint physician, Dr. Bandhu Sahni, made a rare gift to the medical world in general and Homoeopathy in particular, by his discovery of Transmission of Homoeo Drug Energy from a Distance.

Dr. Bandhu Sahni came from a very poor peasant family. He was born on the 17th of January 1925, in a small village called Karkauli, in the District of Darbahanga in Bihar. His early childhood was that of pain and penury. His father being a poor farmer, found it difficult to maintain the family with his meager income. Dr. Sahni's extraordinary intelligence and thirst for knowledge soon attracted the notice of the

Late Munshi Udit Narain of Rajnagar in Darbhanga, a man who was well known for his love of learning and his magnanimity. Under his loving guidance Bandhu lived with the Munshi and he completed his matriculation in 1942 from Rajnagar. That same year his father died leaving him heart-broken.

He then sought admission for I.A. in Darbhanga's C.M. College, however, being a firebrand nationalist, he could not help but take part in the freedom movement of 1942. This made him realize that no sacrifice could be

considered greater than the one offered for the sake of one's country. He left his studies and took an active part in the freedom movement and was jailed on several occasions. It was during this period he was attracted to Homoeopathy, which for him held promises of a new awakening for the poor masses. It was the beginning of a new dawn, which in turn would bring health and happiness to the suffering masses of India.

Dr. Sahni, a man of indefatigable spirit and peerless character took up his studies again and did his graduation from C.M. College, Darbhanga. Afterwards, he joined the Basic Training School at Patna in 1948. Soon after



finishing his BT course he married Dr. Sumitra Sahni, who had done her Basic Training from the same school. Later both of them were appointed as Assistant Teachers in the Basic School at Kolhanta, Patori in the Darbhanga District of Bihar.

At no stage of his career, did Dr. Sahni's interest in Homoeopathy flag. His enthusiasm and commitment helped him complete his MD in Homoeopathy from the Sathi Homoeopathic Medical College in Darbhanga. This prompted him to establish a charitable Homoeopathic Dispensary under the Social Education Scheme. His wife had remained his constant companion throughout.



A voracious reader, Dr. Sahni was always discovering new phenomena in nature. His love of learning always helped him climb newer and brighter heights.

He continued his studies while in service and he completed two postgraduate degrees, one in Philosophy and the other in Sociology. At the same time he competed for a gazette post in the Bihar Public Service Commission and it was while serving at Bhagalpur that Dr. Sahni made the discovery of the Transmission of Homoeo Drug Energy.

THE CONCEPTUAL EVOLUTION:



Dr. Sahni extended the philosophy of Dr. Hahnemann. His discovery of remote sensing technique of administering drugs, as against the conventional methods of administration of drugs by mouth, in 1967, brought revolutionary and far reaching changes in the field of medicine in general and Homoeopathy in particular. Today it is much easier to comprehend this form of therapy given the advances in science and transmission of different forms of energy such as radio waves, television, mobile instruments, computers, etc.

In Dr. Sahni's scheme of drug transmission, a single strand of hair is plucked from any part of the patient's body which is then placed in the dynamic medicine so that one end of the hair is submerged in the medicine which is in liquid form, and other end free in the air to act as an antenna of a transmitter. Hair is used, as it is convenient for the patient to give. Any natural body part of the patient can act as a representative antenna for him/her. This antenna transmits vital energy waves at a particular frequency specific to the patient. The vital energy signals traveling in the air are then received by the body of the patient acting as the receiver of a transmitter. Experiments over a decade have proved that these vital energy



signals can travel thousands of miles instantly without losing their effectiveness. In Homoeopathy it is well understood that cause of any sickness lies within the person himself. Life is governed by a dynamic force with the capability of maintaining itself harmoniously. Disease can be established only by weakening this dynamic force. A diseased person has a disoriented dynamic plane, which needs to be brought back to normalcy. Dynamic medicines are needed to achieve this. Dr. Hahnemann had earlier discovered dynamic medicine by potentizing sing the medicine by extracting out the energy level of it. As such all Homoeopathic medicine are not commodities to be fed by mouth. They start acting as soon as they come in contact with the patient himself. Dr. Sahni added a new dimension to the mode of application of this dynamic medicine property by applying it from a distance using the natural body part of the patient. With various experiments on thousands of patients of various categories he now proved beyond doubt that the dynamic medicine of homoeopathy can be transmitted from a distance Dr. Sahni's discovery is now an established system with thousands of followers all across the globe, so much so that he earned laurels as a physician and a messiah. In the foreword of Dr. Sahni's book "**Transmission of Homoeo Drug Energy From a Distance**" Dr. Jugul Kishore, former President of Central Council of Homoeopathy, rates him even higher than the father of Homoeopathy, Dr. Hahnemann. He writes "*Apparently the author (Dr. B. Sahni) has traveled much beyond Hahnemann when the latter advocated transmission of drug energy olfaction.*" Dr. Sahni's followers now recognize this method of application of medicine as the "**Sahni effect**".

HIS PRACTICE AND THE HURDLES:



A perfectionist by nature, he would not rest until his work was completed. He was well aware that in order to establish his system of medicine, he would have to yield results from the clinics. For this he established the **Research Institute of Sahni Drug Transmission and Homoeopathy** to carry on work in this direction. He

faced many difficulties, which he overcame triumphantly. As it happens with every new discovery, the *Transmission of Drug Energy from a Distance* faced a lot of criticism from different quarters. Nevertheless, his well-wishers and God's grace turned these criticisms into appreciation in the due course of time. His family and a few close friends were his constant support during this period. He remained optimistic and carried on relentlessly treating his patients with the new system of treatment. He got fruitful results for his perseverance and gradually the system and the Research Institute of Sahni Drug Transmission and Homoeopathy established its foothold firmly in the science of Homoeopathy. Later, the Institute was registered under the Society Registration Act of 1986. With the initial activity of propagation, research and training through non-formal methods, the institute is now marching ahead with health care via drug transmission through its various free clinics spread all over the country.

TEACHINGS OF DR. B. SAHNI

Dr. B. Sahni was a very learned scholar who laid the foundation of the **"Transmission of drug energy from a distance"**. He was a very practical man who would not consider any weak suggestion in support of his theories. In search of true knowledge he read a lot books, which increased his wisdom manifold. A student of philosophy in his days at college, Dr. Sahni found the approach of Homoeopathy toward life quite appealing and logical. He engaged himself in other academic activities to find a logical growth of the thoughts and ideas that engrossed his mind regarding the dynamic nature of Homeopathic medicines. The knowledge he attained in Homoeopathy was unquestionably pure and after thorough



testing he was convinced that it was a not a commodity to be fed by mouth. His vast reading of homoeopathic literature and work in clinics made him a great practitioner and propagator of classical homoeopathy. He was a firm believer in the practice of classical homoeopathy to keep the system alive. His knowledge in homoeopathic subjects was at par with his peers. He strongly recommended and put to practice the use of the Repertory in everyday practice. He used to say, "***Repertory is the ship in which the vast ocean of Homoeopathy can be crossed.***" His knowledge in philosophy helped him understand the principles of homoeopathy and he stressed the importance of mental symptoms and its correlation to the physical symptoms in forming the true picture of disease.

In 1974 Dr. B. Sahni traveled extensively to share his valuable experiences as a result of which his students are now found worldwide. His efforts brought a tremendous response from the masses and intellectuals alike and proved the efficacy of his principle and methods of treatment, beyond doubt. With his excellence in the art of application of medicine especially the subject of philosophy medicine and reportorial analysis and the vast experience accumulated through them he attracted many disciples from every corner of the globe. His message has thus spread worldwide.

Dr. B. Sahni, besides being a discoverer, was a great soul with a caring

heart, which won him thousands of followers. He was elected President of Homoeopathic Medical Association of India, Bihar State Branch for two terms. Later on he was elevated to the National post of Vice President of the Homoeopathic Medical Association of India. His sincerity and caliber in Homoeopathy attracted the attention of the Government of Bihar and they nominated him as a member of the Bihar State Homoeopathic Board. He served the board and with his commitment he developed Homoeopathy into a more effective system of Medicine.

A learned man, Dr. Sahni was invited on many occasions for various seminars to present his insights. He made his first presentation to the International Homoeopathic Congress, Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi. This was the introduction of his subject of Drug Transmission to the Homoeopathic fraternity of the world. Learned delegates from all over the world listened to him and he was appreciated widely for his new exploration in the field of medicine. Later on he was also invited to present his paper by the Indian Science Congress on three separate occasions. The chairman of the scientific sessions was impressed with his presentation and appreciated Dr. Sahni's research. His paper was also presented at International Homoeopathic Congress at Calcutta in 1989 and in many of the national and regional seminars.

Dr. Sahni served the Medical fraternity in various capacities. He was visiting Professor to the B.H. Medical College and Hospital at Patna. He was Vice Chairman of the Institute of Healing & Alternative Therapy at Patna. He served on the National Editorial Board of History of Indian Homoeopathy. He was also the first life member of YMCA, Patna Chapter and worked compassionately for the cause of poor and downtrodden.

Dr. Sahni's love of books was well known. His vast collection of books on the subject of medicine alone has now become a treasure trove of knowledge in the form of a library at The Research Institute of Sahni Drug Transmission & Homoeopathy. His collection of rare books is still stored in this library.

A renowned author of Transmission of Homoeo Drug Energy From a Distance, a book that has now run into its fourth edition, opens a vast field of research in energy medicines. He authored many other books and his articles were published in various journals of Homoeopathy. His interest in propagating his theory initiated him to write at regular intervals and he took to journalism quite seriously. He founded the publication of two journals – one in Hindi and the other in English, the quarterly Homoeopathic Journal “Homoeo Tarang” in Hindi and “The Journal of Homoeo Transmission” in English.

Dr. Sahni's philosophical approach to life was evident in everything he did. A responsible man in the family he did his best for them. The philosophy of truth and simple living was the precious jewel that he gave them. He used to share his time with his family and pupils, enriching them with his experiences and vast knowledge. His ideology of life can be seen in an extract from the exordium to the first edition of his book "Transmission of Drug Energy from a Distance" where he writes, *"After all what is the summum bonum of life? Is it amassing wealth or wisdom, or attaining liberation? Why is there unrest in the bosom of human beings? Is man possessing vast wealth happy? If so, why further craving? What is the reason behind that he is not happy? Man is made only of matter, life and mind. If it be so, he should have been happy with the vast wealth and mundane power, but it is not so. He has something transcendental in him. He possesses a spark of Divine light which is clouded by ignorance. He is a rational animal. His animality may be satisfied with sensual pleasures in the material possessions but his rationality and spirituality must demand something immaterial. The material possessions cannot satisfy the immaterial or spiritual entity in man. That is why man is not happy. Then what will make him happy? Attainment of Sachidanand – Consciousness – Existence – Bliss who is omniscient, omnipotent and omnipresent, may be the summum bonum of life."*

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THE DISCOVERY

The Transmission of Drug Transmission was a great landmark in the History of medicine. Never before had the medical faculty dreamt of giving relief to their patients without giving material medicines and complicating more of their constitutions with the ill effects of unnecessary medicines.

Drug Transmission was the outcome of the logical mind of Dr. B. Sahni. A careful observer that he was, he applied his logic to the concepts of Homoeopathic medicines. He says, "Everything of the world has got life within. It has got consciousness latent in it. Even the stone has got latent consciousness as in the living body of man which is the most complex of all divine creation. Homoeopathic medicine is dynamic. The globule, sugar of milk or alcohol is nothing but a vehicle, a carrier and a body. It is material, non-medicinal and non-dynamic but the potentised medicine is immaterial. It is spiritual and vital. *This soul like entity should not be essentially a commodity to be taken orally.* It is consciousness latent in matter (Aurobindo). There is a hierarchy in the scales of consciousness or vibration."

Dr. Sahni's mind was in turmoil and he had sleepless nights over the question of the dynamic nature of Homoeopathic medicines. He was



convinced of the electromagnetic nature of Homoeopathic medicine and the thought of the possibility of channeling it was haunting his mind. His concept was to channel the tremendous amount of electromagnetic energy hidden in a tiny globule of dynamic medicine which is radiating incessantly and the possibility of finding any medium through which this storehouse of energy could be transmitted to the ailing and suffering people. "Radio and thought waves can be transmitted, then why not this subtle energy of Homoeopathic dynamic medicine be transmitted in space to cure ailing human beings?"

This question taxed his mind for a long time until the idea of transmitting the dynamic energy through hair flashed into his mind. The hair of a particular man represents the same constitution in a miniature form. The hair has got the same characteristic vibration as that of the body of the individual and this capacity of vibration, capacity to receive and transmit energy of a particular quality is unchanged, even after the hair or any part of the body is detached or separated from the body, provided the physical form of the detached portion is not changed. When the hair enters the potentized medicine it is in a polarized state and having its own electrical field. The resultant field becomes so intense and rapid that it begins to radiate energy, waves or pulse at a particular frequency. As the vibratory state of hair is same as that of the body from which it is detached, this vibration of hair caused by the effect of medicine creates a similar and



sympathetic vibration in the body. Hair was considered as the medium because it was easy to handle. Otherwise any natural body part of the patient viz. blood, nails etc. can also be taken to represent the patient.

This was a revolution in the field of medical science. An elated Dr. Sahni said, *"It has conquered time and space. It proves supremacy of Homoeopathy over the other pathies in as much as no drug other than the Homoeopathic is transmissible so far."* He went further to prove his discovery with the studies of Homoeopathic dynamic medicines and their effect in the Aura of the body which were photographed using Kirlian Photography. The changes in the photograph before and after the administration of medicine are clearly visible.

METHODOLOGY

Transmission of Drug Energy is no witchcraft, and has its own modus operandi. The Drug energy, which can be transmitted from a distance, requires the proper Homoeopathic selection of medicine. The selection is done keeping the dogmas of classical homoeopathy in mind. Stress on need of mental generals and utility of repertories are well stressed by the discoverer.

The selected medicine in proper potency is taken and its solution prepared in the vial. The strand of hair is dipped in it in such a way that a part of it is outside the glass phial and can be removed in case of improper selection of the remedy. When the hair is in the phial of a medicinal solution then it is "ON" and when the hair is removed from the solution it is "OFF". The solution of the medicine is termed as the **"TRANSMITTING SET."** One of the most important advantages of this system of administration is that in case of medicinal aggravation the hair can simply be removed from the transmitting set and the effect of the medicine ceases, instead of giving antidotes to complicate the case.

THE RECOGNITION:

Dr. Sahni has become a legend in the field of medicine and is remembered in a number of stories of cures related to him. His interest in healing the sufferings of ailing patients is widely appreciated. A man with a heart full of passion for helping to relieve suffering brought patients from all over the country to be treated. He offered his services to many of the Medical Centers and has the distinction of organizing many medical camps to make his discovery available to the poor needy patients in remote villages. He traveled from village to village to help the poor. He is still remembered fondly in the hearts of his patients, pupils and admirers.

Dr. Sahni's thirst for helping and propagating the truth of the art of healing encouraged him to travel abroad. He went to Switzerland, Germany, France, England, Belgium, USA and other countries where he was welcomed as a scientist. He also taught many students during his stay at various countries. At San Francisco he worked with AIDS patients and tried to discover a cure for it. He helped in the establishment of The Healing Center at San Francisco.

His health gradually started deteriorating due to the pressure of work and he got paralyzed after a cerebral stroke in 1990. He helped himself with his own discovery and he lived bedridden for more than seven years. Even while lying on his sick bed he used to deliver lectures on his subject to groups of disciples who used to come to consult him in their difficulties. He started a weekly studies program managed from his bedside. His every moment of life was fruitful. An optimistic Dr. Sahni used to say, *"When even after two centuries this is the position of Homoeopathy, what about my discovery Transmission of Drug Energy From a Distance which is only two decades old. Even so I am confident that it will overcome the obstacles in its adoption."*

Recognizing his services to Homoeopathy and his discovery Dr. Sahni was felicitated posthumously by the Central Council of Homoeopathy, a Govt. of India statutory body, during its silver jubilee celebration in 1999. Vice President of India Dr. S. D. Sharma presented the memento to Dr. B. Sahni, which was received by his son Dr. M. K. Sahani.

A grateful Council paid its homage to this saint by honouring and recognizing his service.

Variously described as a saint, a messiah and a scientist healer Dr. B. Sahni, a down-to-earth person shall remain alive in the hearts of millions. Much before he left for his heavenly abode on 26th October 1997, Dr. B.



Sahni enjoyed the great task of ameliorating the pains of humanity through his remote sensing technique of the application of medicine from a distance. He died a happy man, living his life to the fullest without any regrets. He was satisfied to see his work taken to greater heights on the able shoulders of his son Dr. M. K. Sahani. The Chariot of Drug Transmission is on the roll with The Research Institute of Sahni Drug Transmission & Homoeopathy which is still carrying on the work according to the principles of its founder director. The clinical wing “D. B. Sahni Clinic” has patients from all over the country and the globe being treated by the Homoeo dynamic medicines, using the hair of the patients.
